

Why Choosing an Outsource Partner Makes Good Sense

Outsourcing wood components makes good sense. It can oftentimes save money and enables you to take advantage of other's design and production expertise, thereby saving on the personnel and capital expenditures that would otherwise be required if you were to produce the parts in-house.

If any of these thoughts run through your head, outsourcing is most likely the best decision you can make:

- ▶ I need to increase my productivity, quality, consistency and efficiency
- ▶ I'd like to expand my product offerings
- ▶ I have trouble training new employees
- ▶ I could get more sales if I just had the time
- ▶ Machinery costs too much
- ▶ It's hard to know exact job costs before starting

Typically used for furniture, cabinets, building materials and other decorative wood products, dimensioned wood products include: cut-to-size blanks, edge-glued panels, solid or laminated squares, mouldings, turnings, bendings, upholstered frame stock, interior trim, millwork, staircase parts and component parts for cabinets, such as cabinet doors, face frames, and drawer sides and fronts.

Specified by thickness, width, and length, dimension products are classified into three types: rough dimension, semi-machined dimension or fully mechanized dimension.

Rough dimension stock consists of blanks cut and ripped to specific sizes, normally rough surfaced two sides or more to a nominal size.



Semi-machined dimension is rough dimension parts carried one or more steps further in the manufacturing process, including: finish surfacing, moulding, turning, tenoning, flat sanding, edge or face gluing, equalizing, trimming, mitering, etc., but which will not make the product a completely machined part ready for assembly.

Fully machined dimension parts are completely machined with no additional work necessary prior to assembly. A final polish sanding operation may be required prior to finishing or painting.

What to ask before buying

The secret to buying dimension products is communication. Tell your dimension suppliers exactly how the part is going to be used in your finished product. Discuss tolerances, specifications, and quantities with your dimension suppliers. Ask them

for suggestions to improve lumber yields, production efficiencies, product quality and ways to reduce costs – especially material costs. Since material costs account for over half of the total cost of producing dimension, the use of lower grade materials and optional species can result in dramatic savings. Be sure to discuss alternative solutions to meet your needs.

Dimension buyers also should specify the minimum requirements possible in order to maximize the wood utilization and minimize their costs. To arrive at the most efficient cost, dimension buyers are encouraged to specify only those faces and tolerances necessary to produce a satisfactory wood component product suited to the end use. All too often, a higher grade of material is specified than is actually needed. When this happens, it means

the dimension purchaser is paying more than is necessary.

The WCMA publishes the *Rules and Specifications for Dimension and Woodwork rulebook* to serve as a useful guide for dimension & component manufacturers and buyers. Study reveals component market trends


Overall, the wood products industry is looking good, with demand in cabinetry, furniture, retail fixtures and architectural millwork all projected to rise over the next few years. This also bodes well for the components and dimension manufacturers who supply products to these industries.

A recent survey of these manufacturers found more than half of the respondents supply products to the residential market, particularly in the cabinetry and furniture segments, with sales to commercial markets also strong, albeit to a lesser degree.


The Wood Components Benchmark Study was conducted online in the spring by the Wood Component Manufacturers Association, and the Wood Products Manufacturers Association. The survey provides insight into market sales, product categories, and business performance projections and other relevant information.

The residential market continues to be bolstered by new household formations and an aging population, demographics, and replacement and/or re-modeling of older homes. With survey participants able to select multiple industries, an estimated 20% indicated they provide products for residential cabinetry, compared to 15% for commercial cabinetry, while 18% targeted residential furniture and 40% contract furniture. Other top areas for wood components and dimension stock include: building products (33%), decorative/specialty items including musical instruments, caskets, toys, gifts and novelty items (21%), and industrial products, such as tool handles (24%).

Drilling deeper, when asked what percentage of overall sales were directly attributed to the individual segments, the average for those that selected residential cabinetry as well as residential furniture was 57% for both. Next highest was building products, with an average of

40%, followed by contract furniture (28%), commercial cabinetry (27%), decorative/specialty products (26%) and industrial products (24%).

In looking at the type of components provided, cabinetry, in general, is the number one selection. With

respondents able to choose multiple categories, an estimated 41% indicated they produce cabinet parts, while 35% specified solid wood cabinet doors and another 30% said cabinet doors made from composite panels. In alphabetical order, other products by category include: architectural millwork (40%), chair seats and parts (22%), closet components (25%) cut-to-size blanks (18%), dowels/round (7%), drawer boxes (28%), edge-glued panels (19%), entry doors/windows (14%), flooring (10%), moulding and trim (37%), RV parts (4%), specialty/novelty items (20%), squares/laminated (7%), squares/solid (7%), staircase parts (10%), store fixture components (15%), table parts (17%), tool handles and parts (2%), turnings (15%), upholstered frame stock (4%) and wall paneling (13%).



The primary species being used is Hard Maple, followed by White Oak, Poplar, Red Oak, Walnut and Soft Maple.




